

Lent is a 40-day period leading up to Easter that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. The length of Lent represents the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness before beginning his ministry. It is a time of spiritual renewal and reflection in preparation for observing Good Friday, the death of Jesus, and celebrating Easter, the resurrection of Jesus.

The purpose of Lent is to draw closer to God through prayer, repentance, and self-examination. During Lent, many Christians fast or give up certain indulgences as a form of self-discipline and penance. This may include abstaining from certain foods, activities, or habits.

We invite you to mark your calendars for Wednesday, March 5th at 7:00 p.m. as we begin this Lenten season together on **Ash Wednesday** here at FPC.
